PRIVACY POLICY

Purpose

We protect your privacy. You should feel safe when you entrust your personal data. Therefore, we have established this policy. It is based on current data protection legislation and clarifies how we work to take advantage of your rights and your integrity. The purpose of this policy is to tell you how we treat your personal information, how we use them, who will use them and under what conditions and how you can take advantage of your rights.

Background

We process your personal information primarily to fulfill our obligations to you. Our starting point is to not process your personal information more than is necessary for purpose, and we always strive to use the least integrity-sensitive data.

We also need your personal information to provide you with good service, for example marketing, follow-up and information.

Guidelines

What personal data do we treat?

We only treat personal information when we have a legal basis.

We do not treat personal data other than when they are required to fulfill obligations under contract and law.

Here are examples of personal data we treat:

- Name
- Address
- Mail
- Phone number
- User name

You may request that your personal information be deleted, after which will no longer process your personal information. Keep in mind that withdrawal of consent may mean that we cannot fulfill the obligations we have in relation to you.

We also get access to your personal information as follows:

- Details you provide us directly
- Information that is registered when you visit our website
- Information that we receive when you hire one of our employees
- Information we receive when you sign up for newsletters and other mailings
- Information that we receive when you contact us, seek employment with us, or visit us

Is your personal information processed in a safe way?

We work out routines and practices to ensure that your personal information is handled safely. The starting point is that only employees and other persons within the organization who need personal data to perform their duties should have access to them. Our security systems are developed with your integrity in focus and to a great extent protect against intrusion, destruction and other changes that could endanger your privacy.

When do we share your personal information?

Our starting point is to not disclose your personal information to third parties unless you have consented to it or if it is not necessary to fulfill our obligations under contract or law. In cases where we disclose personal information to third parties, we establish confidentiality agreements and ensure that personal data is processed in a safe manner.
